### **Notes for the attention of the Parents**

- ❖ Parents are expected to produce the Identity Card of their children, whenever they take them out on Visitors Day, Vacations or for any emergency purpose.
- ❖ All bags and baggages brought by the children, will be checked by the authorities concerned when they return to school after their holidays or home visit.
- ❖ Parents will not be allowed to meet the children on any day other than the permitted.
- ❖ Parents are not allowed to enter the Dormitories except on the first and the last working days of the school.
- ❖ Children will be permitted to go home only for important religious or traditional ceremonies like:- House-Warming Ceremony, Marriage of their own brother or sister or on the demise of a family member. Do not approach the authorities for any other occasions.
- ❖ Lack of attendance or irregularity hinders the smooth functioning of the school and at large it reflects on the academic performance of the children. Therefore parents are requested to avoid taking the children frequently for family functions or religions ceremonies.
- ❖ The school strictly restricts parents from feeding their children with Fast Food, Bakery items, Chocolates etc in the school campus. If necessary such items will be given to the children by the school on the request of the parents and the parents will be billed the actuals. Bubble gums, Gutka, Zarda, Pan Parag, Drugs, Smoking etc are strictly prohibited.
- ❖ Parents are requested to see that the students report to the school with in the given date and time.
- ❖ No student is allowed to keep Mobile phones or sim cards with him/her self. If found he / she will be suspended / dismissed.
- ❖ Getting things from outside through the day boarders is a great offence and in such an event both the Day Boarder and the Boarder will be suspended/ dismissed.
- ❖ Parents are requested not to give money; valuable items i.e. Gold Jewellery, electronics, walkman etc. to their children. The school will not be responsible in case of lose.

- ❖ School reserves the right to take necessary decisions on emergency medical situation. In case of minor ailments the parents may not be informed but at the event of some serious cases the Parents/Guardian are informed and they are requested to visit their ward immediately.
- ❖ Giving gifts to the staff or money to the hostel or refectory staff is against the norms of the school.
- ❖ Parents are allowed to make telephone calls from 8.15 p.m. to 8.30 p.m. on every Fridays directly to the mobile given to your ward. Kindly keep the time strictly.
- ❖ In case of new admission, avoid making calls to the children atleast for the first 2 weeks, if necessary parents can be in touch with the warden to know about the progress and welfare of the children.
- ❖ If the child is being withdrawn or expelled from the school, fees once paid will not be refunded.
- ❖ All the girls should be in 1 pony tail, with Black ribbons. In case of short hair Black hair band be used.
- ❖ High thinking and simple living is what we try to inculcate in the lives of our children. Therefore indecent dresses, dying the hair, fashionable hairstyles, heavy chains and bracelets, dangling earrings, [piercing of ears, eyebrows, use of low waste pants (boys)] should be avoided.
- ❖ All correspondence should be addressed to the Principal.

The first semester fees is to be paid on the reopening day.  
 The last date to pay the 2<sup>nd</sup> semester fees is 10.10.2011  
 10% of the due will be charged as fine for each subsequent months.

#### **WITHDRAWAL:**

31-03-2012 will be the last date to intimate the school in written about the withdrawal of the ward from the school for the academic year 2012 – 2013. Failure in this will result in the payment of the 1<sup>st</sup> semester fees for the New Academic year.

**Payments** are to be made by DD or Crossed Cheques in favour of De Paul International school, Mysore.
